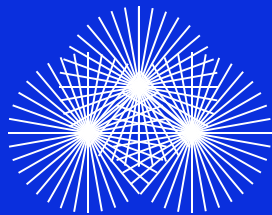

Andrew Michael (South Australia)

Our family have been farming in the mid north of South Australia at Snowtown for more than 100 years and we now have the sixth generation on the same property. We operate a mixed farm with the main focus being sheep in three regions, Snowtown, Keith (South East) and a station east of Burra. Our sheep operation involves the Leahcim Poll Merino stud and commercial flock plus a White Suffolk stud. Leahcim was one of the foundation studs of the White Suffolks and I served on the federal committee from 1987 to 2001 and received a life membership in 2010. Leahcim Poll Merino stud was founded in 1983 with 150 ewes and now consists of 2000 stud ewes selling genetics to all states in Australia plus South America, USA and New Zealand. At Leahcim we have been very focused in using the most advanced technologies available in our breeding program and with careful selection have achieved good performance levels and have ceased mulesing in 2004. Leahcim have been involved in showing at the Royal Adelaide Show since 1980 and I have Judged at every major Royal Show. Some of the breeds I have Judged are Wiltshire's, Dorpers, Hampshire Downs, Texels, White Suffolks, Suffolks, Ryelands, Southdowns, Corriedales, Border Leicester, Sann's, Poll Merino's and Polwarth's.

for 5,6,7 and 8 mm and reducing by five (5) points for every mm outside the range of fat.

Eye Muscle Measurement.....30

Maximum points will be awarded to the sheep with the greatest eye muscle depth in the class reducing by two (2) points for each mm under the greatest eye muscle depth in the class.

Judge.....20

points to be awarded on structure, soundness & wool.
