**Exhibitor Passes:** A Stud Exhibitor Pass consisting of three (3) x 3 day passes must be purchased for \$30.00 at the time of submission of entries. These passes will not be available at any other time. Additional \$10 one day passes may be pre-purchased at time of submission entries if wished. Passes will be returned with receipt and vehicle entry passes after closing date of entries in the stamped, self-addressed envelope sent with Entry Form.
